

# *The Smoke-Free Workplace*

30 minutes of breathing secondhand smoke causes heart damage similar to that of regular smokers.

Being exposed to secondhand smoke increases your chances of developing cancer.

Secondhand smoke contains 11 known cancer causing agents and 250 toxins.

Studies show that co-workers who smoke are less productive, take more breaks, and take more sick days than non-smokers.

The American Samoa Smoke Free Environment Act prohibits smoking in enclosed workplaces to protect the health of you and your co-workers.

If violated, you and your employer could be fined as much as \$250
